there it began to move to the planet's farthest corners today hundreds of artists have recorded house of the rising sun and it can be heard in the most diverse of places chinese karaoke bars gatorade ads and as a ring tone on cell phones anthony began his search in new orleans where he met eric burdon of the animals he traveled to the appalachians to eastern kentucky eastern tennessee and western north carolina to scour the mountains for the song's beginnings he found homer callahan who learned it in the mountains during a corn shucking he discovered connections to clarence tom ashley who traveled as a performer in a 1920s medicine show he went to daisy kentucky to visit the family of the late high lonesome singer roscoe holcomb and finally back to bourbon street to see if there really was a house of the rising sun he interviewed scores of singers who performed the song through his own journey he discovered how american traditions survived and prospered and how a piece of culture moves through the modern world propelled by technology and globalization and recorded sound
